- 2. Draft a training manual on protecting KPA/KAPs, emphasizing their rights and obligations under the laws of Sierra Leone
- 3. Review comments on the training manual and respond to same.
- 4. Deliver the training at a day-long session to KP and KAP- serving agencies
- 5. Participate in media events to discuss the manual
- 6. The services of the Executive Director and other staff of CARL shall be made available to the contractor at all times each week day for the purposes of the work.

A human rights or legal practitioner, with keen interest in human rights protection.
